Different cements, sand, rock, mixing and job-site conditions and contractor technique can alter color from this card. Concrete is produced from natural materials. Surface variation common to uncolored concrete can impact colored concrete.

Release agents bring an antique-look to the concrete and are applied on top of the concrete in an amount you and your contractor will determine together.

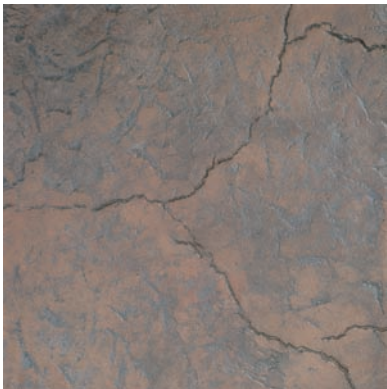
Used Brick - Running Bond Pattern
